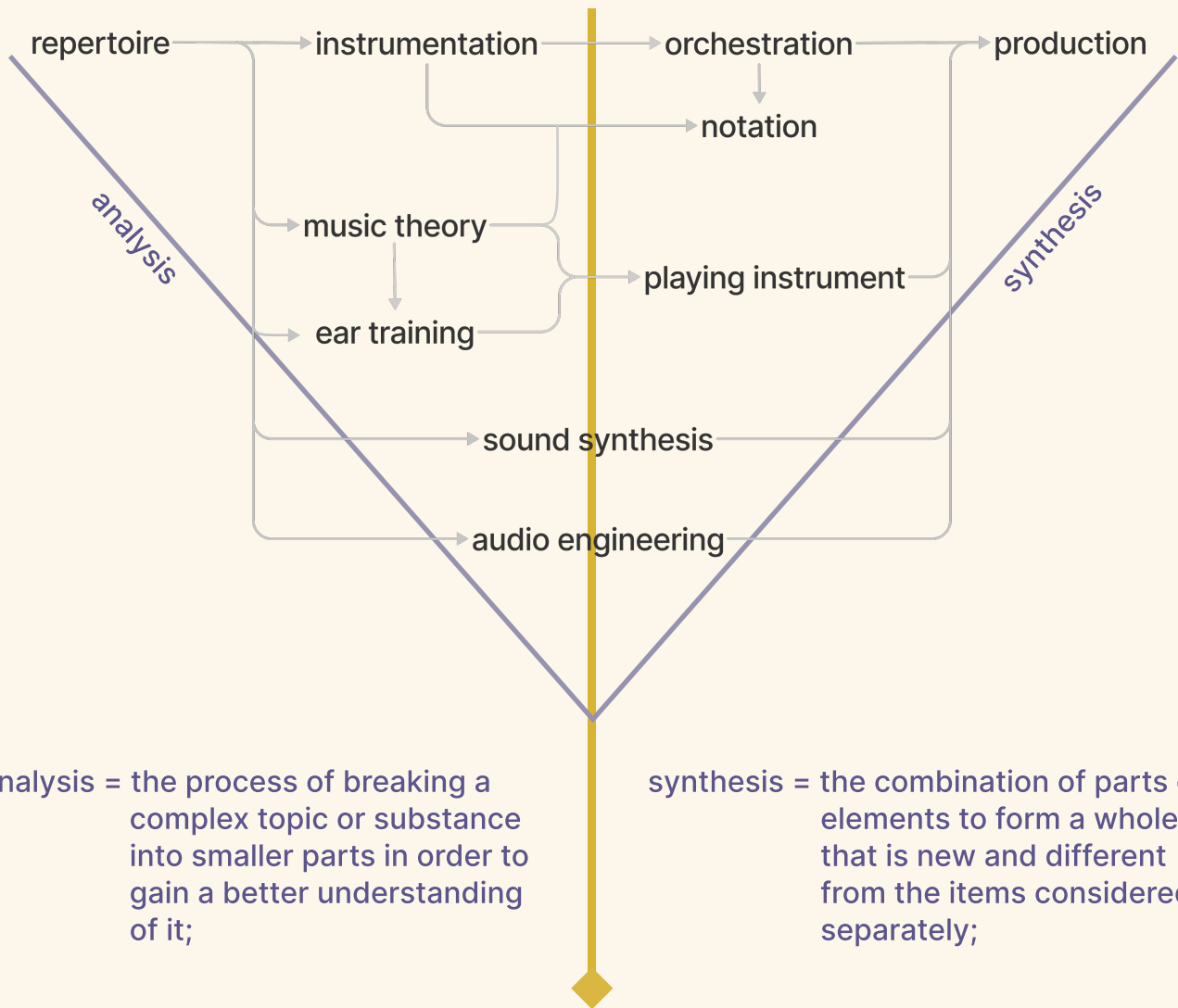


Music Composition Diagram
